Bauer Pottery Company of Los Angeles announces the release of the Bauer Ringware Dog Bowl. The third style of pet dish to be released under the Bauer 2000 line adds the classic ringware pattern to your dog's dining experience.

In addition to the ringware design, the Bauer Ringware Dog Bowl is built taller and narrower than our other two styles and thus is perfect for canines with long ears. "DOG" is embossed across the midline of the bowl. It is available in two sizes and 15 different glazes.

The original Bauer Petware debuted in 1937 and was fired at the company's Plant Two in Lincoln Heights, midway between Pasadena and downtown Los Angeles.

Company Background:

Starting in Louisville, Kentucky, and then flourishing in Los Angeles, California, J. A. Bauer Pottery Company created simple, yet beautiful stoneware from the late 1880s to the early 1960s. After the Depression, inspired by the weather and lifestyles of Southern California, Bauer Pottery introduced new, richly colored styles, which met with overwhelming success.

Today, the work of J.A. Bauer has been reintroduced by a Los Angeles ceramics studio, located just minutes from the original plant. The new Bauer line, Bauer 2000, is being reproduced with an emphasis on items originally manufactured in the 1930s and 40s.
